- Resource Management Plan Update
- Cooperative Agreements and Management Plans for 9 Special Management Areas
- Travel and Transportation Planning for 9 Special Management Areas

Implementation Agreement





The purposes of Implementation Agreement are:

- 1. To ensure the cooperative implementation of the MSHCP by the Parties;
- 2. To describe remedies and recourse should any party fail to perform its obligations
- 3. To provide assurance to the Permittees that:
 - a. Compliance with the IA and the MSHCP constitutes compliance with the Endangered Species Act and relevant laws of the State of Nevada; and,
 - b. Implementation of this IA and the MSHCP will adequately provide for the conservation and protection of the Covered Species and their habitat in the Plan Area; and,
 - c. As long as the terms of the MSHCP are properly implemented, no additional land restrictions or financial compensation for the Covered Species will be required, in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
 - d. Nothing in this IA modifies a Permittee's exercise of powers or authorities under law.
