Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Maryland Parkway and Pyle Avenue Storm Drain.

The project is located on Maryland Parkway and Pyle Avenue and consists of storm drain install. Work includes construction of a horizontal elliptical reinforced concrete pipe (HERCP), storm drain manhole, connection to existing downstream concrete pipe, a drop inlet replacement, abandonment of an existing storm drain pipe, pavement removal and replacement, utility relocations, and pavement striping.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced, or closed at various times for the duration of the project
- Expect new travel lane patterns
- Property access and pedestrian routes will be maintained

Improvement Plans for Kentucky Avenue and Clark Street Storm Drain

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Kentucky Avenue and Clark Street

The project is located on Kentucky Avenue and Clark Street and consists of storm drain install. Work includes construction of a 28.L x 2.W trench drain, a horizontal elliptical reinforced concrete pipe (HERCP), storm drain manhole, construction of a drain headwall, pavement removal and replacement, pavement striping, utility relocations, valley gutter reconstruction, channel excavation, channel reprofiling, and installation of a gravel mulch liner.
