

Hybrid-Electric Bus Delivered to Laughlin, Searchlight Opens New Bocce Ball Court

On Thursday, Feb. 10, Commissioner Michael Naft helped Laughlin and Searchlight celebrate a couple of momentous ribbon-cuttings. First, the Southern Nevada Transit Coalition, debuted Laughlin's new hybrid-electric bus. The 40-foot bus is the first of three environmentally-friendly and efficient buses acquired through a federal grant program facilitated by the Nevada Department of Transportation. This new edition to the "Silver Rider" fleet was handed the baton by a standard gasoline-engine bus that boasted 920,000 miles.

Later that same day, the Searchlight Community Center unveiled its new bocce court at the Rex Bell Jr. Trail Park. The Searchlight Betterment Organization and AARP Nevada were both instrumental in bringing this new amenity to life.

Bocce is most popular in Italy and sometimes referred to as Italian lawn bowling, but the game has been gaining popularity in other countries too. It is simple to play and fun for all ages.
