TIMELINE: Two public meetings were held during the design process in August 2013.


The pipeline started construction in Spring 2014 and was completed in 2015.

MAINTENANCE: Clark County and North Las Vegas have an agreement for maintenance of the pipeline.


The county maintains the channel monthly, or as needed, through contracted services.
