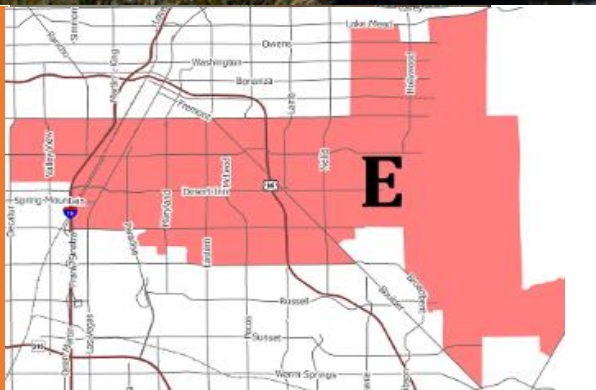
Welcome fall!

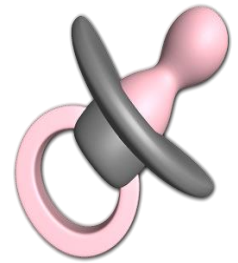
DISTRICT E HIGHLIGHTS

Great Nevada Shakeout October 17th at 10:17 a.m.

The Great Shakeout is a worldwide event that encourages schools, business, and organizations to participate in the annual safety drill. At 10:17 a.m., participants are encouraged to "Drop, Cover and Hold On" if they are at work or home, as if a major earthquake were occurring at that particular moment, and stay in place for 60 seconds. Nevada is the fourth most seismically active state after Alaska, California and Hawaii. Most earthquake-related injuries result from collapsing walls, falling objects and flying glass. The best protection is to get under heavy furniture such as a desk or table until the shaking stops. Also stay away from windows to avoid flying or broken glass.

Road construction updates:

Improvements to **Hollywood Blvd** are close to substantial completion. Stay tuned to details regarding the activating of a new signal and opening of the new bike path. The signal will be at Washington Avenue. The Hollywood Boulevard Improvements include:

- reconstructed roadways
- added asphalt walk
- new bike lanes
- modified signal at Lake Mead
- installation of new signal at Washington Avenue

Hollywood & Sahara -(expected completion in December)

- replaced roundabout with new traffic signal
- activate new signal

Maryland Parkway Reconstruction & UNLV improvements (substantially complete)

- pending possible LED flashers at Cottage Grove crosswalk
- reconstructed roadway
- sidewalks (ADA accessible)
- replaced streetlights with LEDs
- activated new signal at Rochelle/Cottage Grove
