

lately here in the Valley. There are many new and exciting things happening in our district, and I hope you have an opportunity to participate in some of the upcoming events.

There is definitely one thing that we all can participate in, and the the **2020 U.S. Census**. Clark County will be hosting a **2020 Census Kick-off Rally on March 12th**, at the Government Center (see flyer on pg. 5 for more information). If you can, come and enjoy the festivities, and learn more about how participating in the Census can help the State of Nevada, and our community.

I am also hosting a Town Hall at the Hollywood Recreation Center on March 12th, at 5:30 p.m. During this time, we will discuss ways to continue improving the district, as well as, update you on projects that are ongoing and forthcoming! The volunteers tracked demographic information such as gender, age, and ethnicity. They also asked what may have lead the person to becoming homeless, in order to understand their issues, and help alleviate homeliness in the future.

On February 6, Commissioner Segerblom turned on a new traffic signal at Sahara Ave. and Hollywood Blvd. This particular area is undergoing extensive growth with new housing developments being built. "This is a new busy area with lots of neighborhoods all around Las Vegas High School, and this new traffic signal will make the area safer for drivers and pedestrians," said Commissioner Segerblom.
