



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Badura Avenue, Durango Drive to Tenaya Way

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Badura Avenue between Durango Drive and Tenaya Way.

Construction begins Monday July 8, 2024, and is estimated to be completed in March 2025. Work includes the installation of new asphalt pavement, ADA upgrades, traffic signal modifications, LED upgrades, pavement markings, median island modifications, ITS infrastructure, and new storm drain.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced, or closed at various times for the duration of the project.
- Local traffic is encouraged to use alternate routes whenever possible.

The contractor will ensure that access to private residences within traffic control setups will be maintained. Residents whose access may be temporarily affected by construction will be notified by the contractor.
