The board discussed the budget items and will combine numbers 4 & 7 which will now become number 1 under Parks. John Stastny, Parks and Rec, discussed adding more lighting to the southeast parking lot. Under Public Works the board would like item number 1 to read "Repave and Re-engineer Sim".

John Stastny discussed that the fenced Ron Lewis play area project is 60% complete

VIII. Public Comment

3125 Hillside Dr. Grace Perkins – is looking for an update on the marijuana cultivation development that's being proposed. Grace is not opposed to them being located at 3335 Hillside and likes the idea of requesting that the developer potentially paving the road leading to the cemetery. Tim Watkins- Tim and John Wray met with the developer (Ikänik Farms, Inc.) yesterday who was able to provide helpful information as to how their operation would function including details regarding the amount of employees the facility will have which is approximately 40 with two shift changes. Ikänik Farms, Inc. is interested in meeting with the residents of Moapa to help provide clarity regarding the proposed cultivation facility; they anticipate meeting late August or early September. Tim encouraged Grace to speak with her neighbors and encourages everyone to attend. The developer is specifically looking at Moapa because their license is designated for unincorporated Clark County locations and the location on Hillside is ideal for security and financial reasons due to the topography and existing utilities. Once a date has been chosen fliers will be distributed. Tim is in the process of reaching out to the Mayor of a like location in California. Tim asked for an update on the erosion of Henrie Road. Public Works was able to repair some of the damage but there's still existing repairs needed. Amelia will follow up for an update. The I-15 Southbound off ramp remains an area of concern (Exit 91). Tim- Travelers seems to drive through the stop sign which has caused many close calls for those exiting the ramp. Metro is aware of the issues involving this exit ramp. Janice- Amelia is working with NDOT to have them meet with our residents to address concerns and requests. There seems to be confusion where to enter or exit for both Northbound and Southbound travelers. Amelia will also work to provide an update on Terrible Herbst. John Stastny explained that the baseball fields are at full capacity during the month of March when Utah students are on Spring Break after he was asked about the budget item that speaks to additional baseball fields.

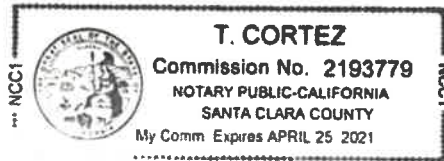

#### Justification Statement

Ladies and Gentlemen:

GK<sup>3</sup>Architecture, on behalf of Terrible Herbst, is requesting the review and approval of a waiver of development standards for a commercial development with a 7,469 SF convenience store with two detached fuel canopies. The store will have slot machines. The building is oriented North/South with standard vehicle traffic at the West portion of the site and RV/Truck traffic to the East. The Southern portion of the site will remain undeveloped. The properties adjacent the site are rural and undeveloped. The building is single story. This site is zoned C-2. The project meets all parking and landscape standards. The required approach distances are maintained for the entrance proposed on Lewis Ranch Road. As designed the project is consistent with the objectives of Title 30 and will not negatively affect neighbors or impact any views.

We respectfully request a Waiver of Development Standards for the sidewalk adjacent Lewis Ranch Rd. With the previously approved WS-18-0812 a detached sidewalk was proposed. Lewis Ranch Road is an NDOT right of way and therefore it is more desirable for the sidewalk to be attached and all of the landscape to be within the property line of the site. This site does not meet the exemption for an attached sidewalk but it does meet the provision of having 15'-0" of landscaping behind the sidewalk.

This project will be an asset to the area. The approval of the proposed design would not constitute a grant of any special privilege. The building would not allow a use or activity which is not permitted in the C-2 Zone and would pose no adverse effect to public health, safety, or welfare.
