Interpretation:

In accordance with Clark County Title 30, a manufactured home may be temporarily established for residential purposes during the construction of a permitted dwelling or the reconstruction of a damaged dwelling.

Field Application:

This installation shall be in accordance with the following application:

- 1. A permit for the manufactured home installation is required. The permit will not be issued until a permit for the single family residence is issued.
- 2. Manufactured housing unit must have a State of Nevada seal, from any year.
- 3. Unit shall be set back a minimum of 5 feet from all property lines.
- 4. The use of a manufactured home is limited to a maximum of 24 months from date of permit issuance.
- 5. Installation will be in accordance with Clark County manufactured housing installation guidelines, with the following exceptions:
 - a. Soil Investigation/Pad Certification is not required for less than 600 square feet.
 - b. Finished Floor Elevation Certification is not required for less than 600 square feet.
- 6. Foundation systems if required shall be plan check approved.
- 7. The temporary residential unit is to be removed within 30 days of completion of the single family residence.
