Interpretation:

Section 110.26(A) provides working clearance requirement for electrical equipment which may require servicing while energized. Transformers shall not be energized while servicing.

Field Application:

The following rules shall apply:

- 1. NFPA/OSHA requires transformers to be de-energized before removing the cover.
- 2. NFPA/OSHA requires transformers to be de-energized while making terminations or changing taps.
- 3. The NEC only requires the working clearance at electrical equipment likely to require examination, adjustment, servicing, or maintenance while energized.
- 4. As transformers are not allowed to be energized with the cover removed, they will not be energized while servicing, and the working clearance requirements do not apply.
