Interpretation:

A 120-volt receptacle shall be located within 25 feet of mechanical equipment for service and maintenance purposes.

Field Application:

Receptacle requirements shall be as follows:

- 1. <u>Residential (existing)</u>: When replacing mechanical equipment in association with a residential property, it shall not be necessary to add a receptacle within 25 feet of the equipment if an outlet is in accordance with 210.52 (E) 1-3.
- 2. <u>Commercial (existing)</u>: When replacing mechanical equipment in association with commercial properties, a receptacle must be installed within 25 feet of the equipment, and it shall be located on the same level as the equipment.
- 3. <u>New Residential and Commercial Structures</u>: New residential and commercial projects shall require a receptacle within 25 feet of the mechanical equipment and located on the same level as the equipment.
