SUBJECT: TG-92-2014 SYSTEM COMMISSIONING

- **1.0 PURPOSE: 22.02.500 Other Inspections.** The Building Official may require other inspections of any work to ascertain compliance with this Chapter and the technical codes. System Commissioning is required in the International Energy Conservation Code.
- **2.0 SCOPE:** This guideline provides information for the listing of approved system commissioning agencies. This guideline also provides information for the testing, reporting, submittal, review and acceptance of system commissioning performed by the approved agencies.

DEFINITIONS: For the purposes of this technical guideline, certain terms, phrases, words and their derivatives shall be construed as specified in this section and the Building Administrative Code of Clark County.

Approved Agency: An agency that is approved by the Building Official to perform inspections.

5.0 **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

5.1 <u>Permit Holder</u>:

- 5.1.1 The permit holder shall engage an approved agency with the SC approval to perform all required testing services.
- 5.1.2 The permit holder shall coordinate testing services with the approved agency.
- 5.1.3 The permit holder shall schedule required inspections with CCBD.

5.2 <u>Clark County Building Department – Plans Examination</u>

- 5.2.1 Staff will confirm that a commission plan is submitted in accordance with the requirements of the IECC.
- 5.2.2 Staff shall ensure that the commission plan is submitted by a Nevada registered design professional or an approved agency with the SC approval.
- 5.2.3 Staff will add a commission testing requirement to the permit.
- 5.2.4 Three copies of the commissioning plan shall be approved, one copy shall be included in the permit drawings, one copy shall be included in the records, drawings, and one copy shall be forwarded to the inspection division.

5.3 <u>Clark County Building Department – Green Construction</u>

- 5.3.1 Staff will use the commissioning plan to add mechanical and/or electrical system commissioning clearances as required inspections to the appropriate permits.
- 5.3.2 Staff shall review the final commissioning report and disposition the commissioning clearance.

5.4 <u>Approved Agency</u>:

- 5.4.1 The agency designated to perform the system commissioning services shall be approved by Clark County with the SC approval.
- 5.4.2 Only Clark County approved inspectors shall perform the system commissioning.
- 5.4.3 The agency and inspectors shall comply with all applicable technical guidelines.
- 5.4.4 An agency seeking approval status shall apply for approval using forms available for that purpose. Forms are available at CCBD website @ <u>http://www.clarkcountynv.gov/depts/development_services/engineering/Pages/H</u> <u>owToGuides.aspx</u>. In order to obtain approval, an agency must comply with BAC and TG-15, 16, 17, 20, 22, 50, 80, and 100.
- 5.4.5 The agency shall not submit preliminary commissioning reports.
- 5.4.6 The agency shall submit the final commissioning report to CCBD by email (greencst@clarkcountynv.gov) for each permit that commissioning is required.

6.0 **PROCEDURES**:

6.1 Testing Procedures

- 6.1.1 The inspector shall utilize the approved construction documents while performing their duties.
- 6.1.2 The inspector shall perform and document the testing as required in the approved commissioning plan, IECC, technical guidelines, BAC and all other applicable code and standards.

6.2 Final Commissioning Report

- 6.2.1 The report shall contain the following information:
 - 6.2.1.1 Form 845 Certificate of Compliance Commissioning
 - 6.2.1.2 A list of the inspectors who performed the testing on the project.
 - 6.2.1.3 Results of systems adjusting and balancing testing.
 - 6.2.1.4 Results of functional performance testing.
 - 6.2.1.4.1 Functional performance test procedures used during the commissioning process including measureable criteria for test acceptance.
 - 6.2.1.5 Results of lighting system functional testing.
 - 6.2.1.6 Noncompliance reports and record of corrections that show that deficiencies found during testing has been corrected.
- 6.2.2 The agency shall submit the final commissioning report to CCBD by email (greencst@clarkcountynv.gov) for each permit that commissioning is required.

6.2.3 Acceptance of the final commissioning report by CCBD personnel will result in an entry of an approval of the required clearance of the permit.

7.0 **RECORDS:**

The final commissioning report is a record maintained by CCBD.
