What is Automatic Record Clearance?

Think "state-initiated" record sealing... rather than the burden being on impacted folks to file a petition, the state instead "automatically" starts and completes the process for them.



With automatic record clearance, existing government systems are utilized, with minimal human involvement, to proactively seal eligible criminal records instead of people in Clark County having to navigate the existing burdensome, time-consuming, and often costly process. **Government has the ability to remove barriers for tens of thousands of Nevadans,** opening up opportunities like jobs, housing, and education previously out of reach because of a criminal record.




Understanding the Current State




In the coming weeks, we will:

- Map stakeholder & data ecosystems: We will consult with stakeholders who engage with data and systems relevant to current and automatic record sealing
- Document process, information, and eligibility flows: We will develop detailed documentation of interactions and flows from end to end in record sealing, including key touchpoints, systems, statutory factors, timescales, resources and repositories
- Surface barriers and solutions: We will identify factors in available data and existing process that will need to be addressed to stand up automatic record sealing







Deliverables may include technical assessments, recommendations, data flow diagrams, process and eligibility flows.

Deliverables

Documents that detail the current state of the county's criminal justice infrastructure, processes and data related to record sealing.

Recommendations on the technology, service and process updates required to automate record sealing.


Automatic Record Clearance Landscape
