The 2024 elections will be here before we know it! Preparations will start about mid-year in 2023. Nevada will have its first Presidential Preference Primary in February 2024 along with the regular Primary Election in June and the General Election in November. Some important dates include:

February 6, 2024	Presidential Preference Primary Election Day only for major party candidates for U.S. President
March 4-15, 2024	Candidate filing (non-judicial)
May 14, 2024	Close of standard registration for the Primary Election
May 24-June 7, 2024	Early voting for the Primary Election
June 11, 2024	Primary Election Day
October 8, 2024	Close of standard registration for the General Election
Oct. 19-Nov. 1, 2024	Early Voting for the General Election
November 5, 2024	General Election Day
