

ELECTION WORKERS NEEDED NOW

Overview:

The Clark County Election Department needs poll workers for the 2024 General Election. Those who can work both during Early Voting and on Election Day are preferred. Workers who are fluent in English and Spanish, Filipino, or Mandarin Chinese are especially needed.

When: General Election:

- Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024
- Early Voting, from October 19 (Sat.) to November 1, 2024 (Fri.)

Pay:

- Election Day poll workers receive a flat rate of \$200 for the day
- Early voting poll workers are paid \$17 per hour
- Workers who are required to attend training will receive \$50 for the class

Requirements: All poll workers must meet all of the requirements below:

- Be a registered voter in Clark County, NV, or, be enrolled in High School and at least 16 years of age
- Not be a candidate or relative of a candidate for nomination or election in 2024
- Not be a poll watcher or observer during the current election
- Successfully complete the Election Department's training (if training is required)
