# 2021 BOULDER CITY ELECTION IMPORTANT DATES

The important dates for the 2021 Boulder City Election are as follows:

- ❖ January 26 – February 4, 2021 - Candidate Filing will be held at the Boulder City Clerk’s Office for the City Council Member contest.
- ❖ March 9, 2021 - Close of Standard Registration: Last day to register to vote or to update your existing registration by mail or in-person at the Election Department.
- ❖ March 23, 2021 - Last day to register online through the Secretary of State’s Website at [www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov](http://www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov).

**Boulder City - Same Day Registration Period\*** – Voters that register during this period will be required to present an unexpired Nevada Driver’s License or Identification Card issued by the DMV. If you are already registered and you update your record during this period, you do not have to present ID. See our website for more information regarding Same Day Registration requirements at [www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote](http://www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote). Same Day Registration will be available at all Election Day Vote Centers or early voting sites. For online registration/updates go to [www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov](http://www.RegistertoVoteNV.gov).

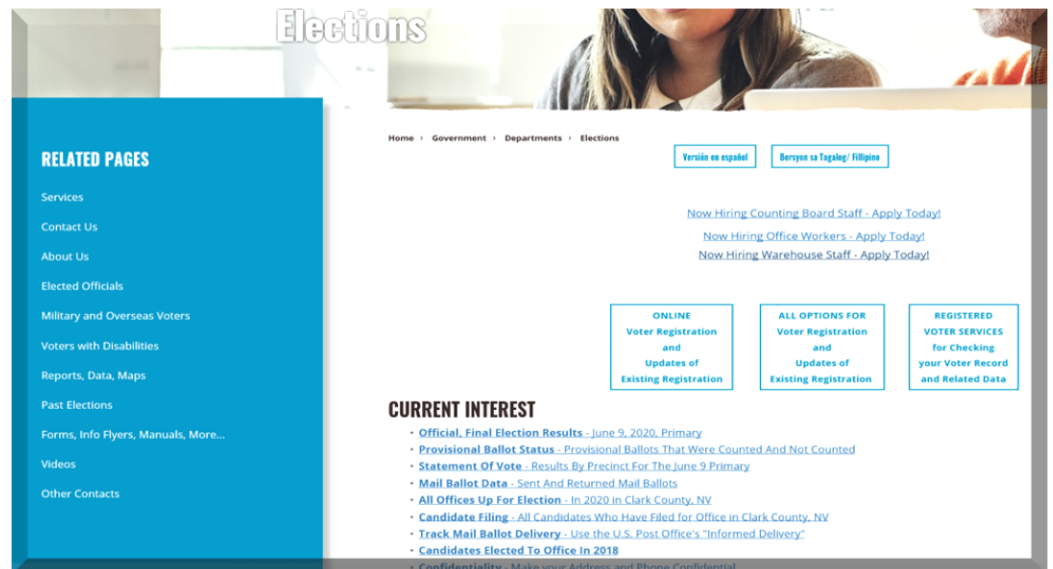
