City of Henderson's Ward I Special Election

The City of Henderson will be conducting a special election to fill a City Council vacancy in Ward I. You must be registered at a residential address in Henderson's Ward I to vote in this election. Same-day registration and updates, both in-person and online, will be available. Important dates include:

- Ballot Drop-Off: March 20-April 3 (Monday-Thursday, Closed Friday-Sunday), Henderson City Hall (240 S. Water St., Henderson) and the Clark County Election Department (965 Trade Dr., North Las Vegas), 7:30am-5:30pm
- Early Voting: March 28-30 (Tuesday-Thursday), Henderson City Hall, 7:30am-5:30pm
- Election Day: April 3 (Monday), Henderson City Hall, 7am-7pm



Check Your Registration and Districts

If you are registered to vote in Clark County, NV, you may check online that your address in your voter registration is current, what your political districts are, and who your elected officials are by logging in to "Registered Voter Services" at www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/voter_services.php. You will immediately see your address. To view all of your districts and elected officials, select "View My Elected Officials" from the dropdown menu at the top of the page. Or click "View All Elected Officials..." at the bottom of the page. You may do this to see if you are registered in the City of Henderson's Ward I and therefore eligible to vote in their upcoming special election.



Electronic Sample Ballots

At any time, you may request to receive an electronic sample ballot by e-mail instead of a paper one sent through the post office. This will help save County taxpayer dollars by reducing printing, paper, and mailing costs. You may submit your request online by logging in to "Registered Voter Services" at www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/voter_services.php. Then click "Request My Sample Ballot Electronically (Go Green)" from the dropdown menu. After we receive your request, we will send you a confirmation by e-mail. Please be aware that Nevada law requires that the e-mail address of anyone who requests an electronic sample ballot be kept CONFIDENTIAL and may not be given to third parties (NRS 293.558). Mail Ballot Opt-Out

Nevada Secretary of State In Nevada, all eligible "active" voters who registered to vote no later than 14 days before a Primary or General Election will automatically receive a mail ballot, unless they opt-out. Please note you may still vote in-person on a voting machine instead of by mail at any Early Voting Site or Election Day Vote Center if you surrender your mail ballot, sign a legal affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election, or opt out of mail ballot voting.

> To opt-out of receiving a mail ballot at any time, you must submit an online or printed "Mail Ballot Preference Form." You may also use the form to opt-in again if you had previously opted out or to request to vote by mail only in specific elections.

- To electronically submit your mail ballot preferences online, log in to "Registered Voter Services" on the Secretary of State's website at www.nvsos.gov/votersearch
- A printable PDF form is also available from the Election Department at www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/services/mail-ballots.php

The Election Department must receive the printed or online "Mail Ballot Preference Form" no later than 60 days before Election Day if you wish to optout starting with the current election. The deadline to opt-in if you had previously opted-out is the fourteenth day before a Primary or General Election Day.
