## **POSITION DESCRIPTION DETAILS**

### **POLL PAD OPERATORS PPO** *(Training Required)*

- Check-in voters using the Poll Pad. (Must have computer experience).
- Follow correct sequence outlined in the manual and on the Poll Pad Operator's Steps for Processing a Voter.

### **MONITORS** *(Training Required)*

- Post indoor and outdoor signs prior to opening site. Also, put away at the end of the day.
- Assist Voters at the voting machines – this requires that Monitors stand and walk around for most of day.
- Observe voting machine LED lights throughout the day and alert the Team Leader or Assistant if there is a problem (light is flashing red or flashing different colors).
- Collect vote cards and pass out "I Voted" stickers. (This task is rotated between Monitors).

### **LINE MONITOR**

- Manage the line, determining voter needs.
- Direct voters to appropriate area to begin the voting process.

### **MAIL BALLOT CLERK**

- Voters will come to drop off their voted Mail Ballots.
- Ask voter if they are there to vote in person on the voting machine or to drop off voted mail ballot.
- Make sure that the voter has signed their envelope, and that the envelope is sealed.
