## The General Election is November 5, 2024

General Election Day is November 5, the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, and Early Voting is from October 19 to November 1 (14 days). You may vote for all contests, candidates, and questions on the ballot for your precinct, regardless of your party affiliation. You may vote in the General Election even if you did not vote in the Primary Election. Candidates who receive the most votes in the General Election are elected to office.

This year (and every four years), U.S. President and Vice President will be on the General Election ballot. Major political parties nominate these candidates at their party's national convention. In Nevada, qualified candidates for President and other partisan offices who have a party affiliation other than Democratic or Republican only appear on the General Election ballot and do not go through the Primary Election process. ## Key Important Dates for the 2024 General Election

**November 5, Tuesday, is Election Day**

**October 19–November 1, Friday-Saturday, is Early Voting**

**Sept. 6, Friday - Deadline to Opt-Out of Mail Ballots:** The last day for the Election Department to RECEIVE PRINTED OR ONLINE requests from voters to not be sent a mail ballot is 60 days before Election Day.

**Sept. 21, Saturday - Deadline for the Start of Mailing of Military and Overseas Ballots:** Mail ballots must be ready for distribution to military and overseas voters no later than 45 days before Election Day.

**Sept. 26, Thursday - Deadline for the Start of Mailing of Out-of-State Ballots:** Mail ballots must be ready for distribution to out-of-state voters no later than 40 days before Election Day.

**Oct. 8, Tuesday - Deadline for Standard Registration:** October 8, the fourth Tuesday before Election Day, is the last day to register to vote or to update your existing registration without having to do so on the Secretary of State's website or through same-day registration.

**Oct. 9-22, Wednesday-Tuesday - Online Only Extended Registration and Updates (14 Days):** During this time period in Clark County, NV, you may register to vote or update your existing registration online ONLY on the Secretary of State's website at <https://RegistertoVote.NV.gov>. You will still automatically be sent a mail ballot. You may also opt to vote in-person (instead of by mail) on a voting machine at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center within the County.

**IMPORTANT:** If you register or update your existing registration online or in-person on or after Oct. 23, 2024, then for the current election you may only vote in-person at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center as required by the [same-day registration and updates](#) process. You may not vote by mail. Additionally, new registrants may only vote a [provisional ballot](#).

**Oct. 16, Wednesday - Deadline for the Start of Mailing of In-State Ballots:** Mail ballots must be ready for distribution to in-state voters no later than 20 days before Election Day.

**Oct. 17, Thursday - No Mailing of Sample Ballots to New or Updated Voters:** If you register to vote or update your existing registration on or after this date (less than 20 days before the General Election), you will not be mailed a sample ballot for the current election for the new or updated registration.

**Oct. 19-Nov. 1, Saturday-Friday - Early Voting, (14 Days):** Any voter registered in Clark County (including those who received a mail ballot and instead wish to vote in-person on a voting machine) may vote at any Early Voting site within the County. In-person [same-day registration and updates of existing registration](#) will be available. All Early Voting sites also serve as mail ballot drop-off locations during voting hours. Dates and hours vary by location.

**Oct. 22, Tuesday - Deadline to Opt-In Again to Mail Ballot Voting (If You Had Previously Opted-Out):** The last day for the Election Department to RECEIVE PRINTED OR ONLINE requests to opt-in again to mail ballot voting (if you had previously opted-out) is 14 days before Election Day.

**Oct. 23-Nov. 5, Wednesday-Tuesday - Online Same-Day Registration and Updates (14 Days):** Through Election Day, register to vote or update your existing registration online on the Nevada Secretary of State's website (<https://RegistertoVote.NV.gov>). You will NOT be mailed a sample ballot for the current election for the new or updated registration, and you may NOT vote by mail. You may only vote in person on a voting machine at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center of your choice within the County. New registrants may only vote a [provisional ballot](#).

**NOVEMBER 5, 7AM-7PM, TUESDAY - GENERAL ELECTION DAY:** The General Election must be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November of each even-numbered year. Any voter registered in Clark County (including those who received a mail ballot and instead wish to vote in-person on a voting machine) may vote at any Election Day Vote Center within the County. In-person [same-day registration and updates of existing registration](#) will be available. All Election Day Vote Centers also serve as mail ballot drop-off locations from 7am to 7pm.

**Nov. 8, 5pm, Friday - Provisional Ballot ID and/or Proof of Residence Deadline (ONLY IF NEEDED):** Last day the Election Department can receive Identification (ID) and/or Proof of Residency (POR) from the [provisional ballot](#) voters who must provide this documentation (the affected voters will have been informed if this is needed).

**Nov. 8, 5pm, Friday - Deadline for Receiving Voted Mail Ballots with Indeterminate Postmarks:** If a mail ballot is received by mail not later than 5pm on the third day following the election and the date of the postmark cannot be determined, the mail ballot shall be deemed to have been postmarked on or before the day of the election.

**Nov. 9, 5pm, Saturday - Deadline for Receiving Voted Mail Ballots Returned Via the Post Office:** By 5pm on the fourth day after Election Day, the Election Dept. must receive voted mail ballots postmarked no later than Election Day.

**Nov. 12, 5pm, Tuesday - Deadline for Curing Mail Ballot Signature Issues:** If a question arises about your signature on the outside of your mail ballot return envelope or if you did not put your signature on the outside of that envelope, the Election Department will notify you using the contact information in your voter registration. You will have until 5pm on the sixth day after Election Day to provide a signature confirmation or an actual signature.

**Nov. 15, Friday - Deadline for County Canvass:** The Board of Clark County Commissioners must canvass the General Election results on or before the tenth day after the General Election.

**Nov. 20, Wednesday - Deadline to Demand a Recount for Contests and Questions Only Affecting Clark County and Its Cities:** The demand must be submitted to the Clark County Registrar of Voters within three working days after the County Commission's canvass.

**Nov. 26, Tuesday - Nevada Supreme Court's Canvass:** Must be conducted on the fourth Tuesday in November after the General Election.

**Dec. 3, Tuesday - Deadline to Demand a Recount for Contests and Questions Affecting Multiple Counties:** The demand must be submitted to the Nevada Secretary of State within three working days after the Nevada Supreme Court's canvass.
