A. <u>APPEALS</u> 1. WILLDEN & WILLDEN, INC. – NOV #8358 – Willden & Willden, Inc. (Willden) is appealing the Air Pollution Control Hearing Officer’s Order. On November 15, 2012, the Hearing Officer found Willden in violation of Air Quality Regulations Subsection 12.1.3.1 for operating a gasoline dispensing operation without a minor source permit identified during a compliance evaluation on February 9 and March 7, 2012 at the America’s Mart #1 facility (New Source: 17161), located at 2800 East Tropical Parkway, Suite 100, in Clark County, Nevada. A penalty of \$4,000 was assessed. 2.	Board denied appeal. Board found Willden & Willden in violation. \$4,000 penalty assessed.
