During the reporting period, we finalized the project database and submitted the annual data (D13) and the annual report (D14) on December 27, 2024. The database includes all project meta data, information about project components and background, and survey data collected during 2024. Unknown plant species surveyed in the field have been identified and the database corrected to reflect species detected. Additionally, we have begun analyses for some of the case studies, with results anticipated by early 2025, and are currently organizing project data for analyses. We have reached the goal of completing the most important field data collection and beginning data organization and analysis by the end of 2024.

We did not encounter any unexpected problems.
