




Permit Condition K

- Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan
- Permit Condition K
 - Acquire riparian lands to preserve as habitat for covered riparian birds
 - Muddy, Virgin Rivers and Meadow Valley Wash
 - 6 covered riparian birds
 - Summer tanager
 - Blue grosbeak
 - Arizona Bell's vireo
 - Yellow billed cuckoo (T)
 - Southwestern willow flycatcher (E)
 - Vermillion flycatcher











- Virgin River
 - Bunkerville area
 - Mesquite area
 - 2 parcels in County Treasurer possession, 65 acres

 Worked with CC Public Works and a local property owner to establish access routes and facilitate future restoration efforts

- Limited access

Continued Weed Management (NPS)

- Survey and map location and extent of weeds
- Treat annual and perennial weeds
- Seeing some natives pop up!

Noxious Weeds

- Malta star thistle
- Puncture vine
- Australian saltbush
- Russian thistle
- Russian knapweed
- London rocket

- NPS crews also conducted 5 acres of restoration planning and native seeding

Future Steps - Riparian Reserves

- Initiate baseline bird surveys on Riparian Reserves
- Continue riparian property acquisition
- Website updates
- Water rights planning



Future Steps - Virgin River Reserve

- Initiate weed management/ botanical inventory on Virgin River
- Continue restoration of Virgin River 1- Round 15 SNPLMA
 - Additional plantings
 - Monitoring
 - Fence improvements
- Baseline restoration/acquisition assessment




Future Steps-Muddy River

Muddy River grading plan

- Grading plan contract in development
- Excavate down to ideal planting substrate for riparian trees
- Lower depth to ground water
- Creation of a terraced landscape
 - 2 or 3 terraces
 - Riparian forest and upland terraces
 - Possible streamside marsh terrace
- Remote property restoration
 - Tamarisk removal
 - Upland vegetation planting
