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# Endangered Species Act (ESA)



#### **Endangered Species Act of 1973**

"...to provide a means whereby the ecosystems upon which endangered species and threatened species depend may be conserved [and] to provide a program for the conservation of such ... species..."

- Section 10(a)(1)(B) Habitat Conservation Plans & Incidental Take Permit
  - A plan prepared by non-federal parties wishing to obtain permits for incidental take of threatened and endangered species
  - Describes the anticipated effects of proposed take and how these effects will be minimized and mitigated



The Desert Conservation Program serves as the Administrator of the Clark County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) and incidental take permit



#### **Clark County MSHCP**



- 30-year permit effective February 2001 February 2031
- Take cannot exceed 145,000 acres
- Covers all non-federal land in Clark County
- Covers 78 species
  - > Threatened
    - Desert Tortoise
    - ➤Yellow-billed cuckoo
  - > Endangered
    - Southwestern Willow Flycatcher
    - Mt. Charleston blue butterfly
- Permittees collect a \$550 per acre disturbance fee to fund implementation
- Minimizes and mitigates the impacts of development by funding conservation actions; minimum required expenditure





  - Science Advisor
  - Public Comment
- Approved by Clark County Board of County Commissioners




- Provides an update on the overall implementation of the MSHCP

#### **Progress Per Biennium**





#### \$123 million from 2001 - Present






#### Land Disturbance & Fees



- 2015 1,969.72 acres disturbed; \$1.08 million
- 2016 3,950.17 acres disturbed; \$2.17 million
- 2017 1,485.24 acres disturbed; \$0.82 million
- 70,154.03 acres remain; \$44.9 million earned to date





From July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017


Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument, in planning
