The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project is to provide property maintenance and the maintenance of mesquite/catclaw and desert riparian habitats along the Muddy River and Virgin River Reserves that support conservation and enhancement of habitat for species covered by the MSHCP. Services provided included picking up litter and trash, repairing gates and fencing, invasive and noxious weed treatment, and selective vegetation clearing.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Muddy River Reserve Unit:

- Clearing of gates after flood event
- Clearing of vegetation from access roads and monitoring wells
- Repaired break in perimeter fence on Parcel H
- Russian Thistle removal and disposal

Virgin River Reserve Unit, Riverside Subunit:

- Removal and disposal of desk and abandoned vehicle
