The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project was to document presence and activity of bat species at the Riparian Reserve Units and Boulder City Conservation Easement; these data established a baseline record against which future restoration activities can be measured.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Thirteen species of bats were acoustically detected within the project area. In particular, high bat species diversity was observed at the Muddy River Unit and the Riverside Subunit, which is likely associated with an abundance of attractant features and roosting sites within and near these locations.
