The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The main purpose of the project was to provide a peace officer to patrol the Boulder City Conservation Easement property on a regular basis to enforce applicable ordinances, resolutions, orders, regulations and prohibited uses. The Boulder City Police Department was tasked to provide law enforcement services within the BCCE to ensure the viability of the BCCE as a Desert Tortoise (*Gopherus agassizii*) habitat, coordinating its law enforcement activities with law enforcement branches of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife service, the Bureau of Land Management, and the National Park Service.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

The Boulder City Conservation Easement was successfully patrolled.
