# FACTS ABOUT FOSTERING



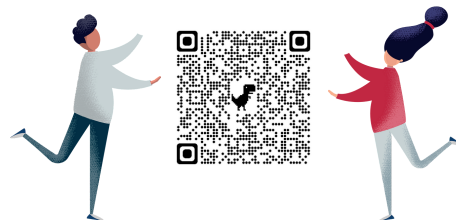
- You can be single, married or in a partnership.
- You can be a working or stay-at-home parent.
- You can choose the age-range and gender of child you are most comfortable parenting.
- You do not have to own your home to provide foster care.
- For family foster care, you can be licensed for one to six beds, depending on space availability.

# FOSTER PARENT LICENSING TIMELINE

- STEP 1** Attend a foster care information session.
- STEP 2** A Family Services Technician will call to schedule your fingerprinting & background check.
- STEP 3** Turn in documentation.
- STEP 4** Attend your weekly training. Training is in-person, 3 hours per week for 9 weeks. Complete some additional training online.
- STEP 5** Schedule an appointment with your DFS Licensing worker for your Home Study.
- STEP 6** Prepare your home.
- STEP 7** Complete training/licensure.
- STEP 8** Welcome your first foster child(ren) into your home!

**On average, foster care licensing takes approximately 3+ months.**
