- For family foster care, you can be licensed for one to six beds, depending on space availability.

FOSTER PARENT LICENSING TIMELINE

- **STEP1** Attend a foster care information session.
- **STEP 2** A Family Services Technician will call to schedule your fingerprinting & background check.
- **STEP 3** Turn in documentation.
- **STEP 4** Attend your weekly training. Training is in-person, 3 hours per week for 9 weeks. Complete some additional training online.
- **STEP 5** Schedule an appointment with your DFS Licensing worker for your Home Study.
- **STEP 6** Prepare your home.
- **STEP 7** Complete training/licensure.
- **STEP 8** Welcome your first foster child(ren) into your home!

On average, foster care licensing takes approximately 3+ months.
