

SNHD APPROVED EMT CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

All Clark County Firefighters are certified as Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians (AEMT) and must maintain that as a minimum certification throughout their career. The certifications are always desirable and often required prior to even applying for employment as a Clark County Firefighter. The EMT certification must be obtained before the AEMT and if desired the AEMT before becoming a Paramedic. The following agencies provide the necessary classes to obtain these certifications.
