The Family Dollar Store in Sandy Valley is on track for a grand opening before Halloween. Meggan reported she had received several questions regarding wells on lots of one acre in size or less. Per her discussion with the State Water Engineer, wells are permitted on lots as small as 0.89 acres without a variance if it is a legally created lot and there is at least 100 feet separation between the well and septic. On legal lots that are smaller than 0.89 acres, a variance was approved by the Southern Nevada Health District, but the 100 foot separation is still required.
