



HELP CREATE A LASTING 1 OCTOBER Memorial



3 Pathways for Participation

We invite you to help create a lasting memorial that remembers the 58 lives lost on 1 October 2017, as well as those who have succumbed to injuries since the tragic events at the Route 91 Harvest Music Festival. The memorial will also honor the survivors, first responders and everyday heroes who inspired our nation with their bravery while also recognizing the resiliency and compassion of our community.

CALL FOR CREATIVE EXPRESSIONS

July 1 – Sept. 30, 2022

Anyone wishing to express an idea for a memorial or other forms of creativity to inspire design teams is invited to participate in this call. Submissions can be drawings, short videos, poems, songs etc., along with a letter of intent. Individual artists interested in contributing to the creation of a memorial are invited to share their resumes or portfolios. Submissions will be available on a public website for viewing if participants grant permission. Professional design teams will be encouraged to review all Creative Expressions submissions to inform their concepts for the memorial, and the public will be able to view the formal design proposals before a selection is made next year.

CALL FOR QUALIFICATIONS/ PROFESSIONAL RFQ TEAMS

Aug. 1 – Oct. 31, 2022

Professional artists and design teams, including an architect licensed in Nevada, with expertise and capacity to design a world-class memorial, may submit an Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to express interest in submitting a proposal for a memorial. RFQs will be evaluated in the fall. Up to five finalists will be invited to develop a formal proposal, including design concept, model and budget, by May 31, 2023.

CALL FOR EVALUATORS/HELP SELECT THE DESIGN TEAM

July 1 – 31, 2022

A seven-person volunteer panel, as well as alternates, will be comprised of stakeholders who represent family members of the victims, survivors, first responders, three industry experts (engineering, architecture, cultural history, music, art, etc.) and an appointed representative from Clark County's Real Property Management Department which oversees design and construction of County projects. The panel will review and evaluate the qualifications of the professional design firms seeking to engage in the 1 October Memorial process.

Up to 5 professional design teams will be selected to develop memorial concepts influenced by public submissions for the memorial's design.

1 October Memorial Committee to make formal design recommendation to the Clark County Commission.
