Please consider my request to evaluate the art installation at Eastern and I-215. The bold head sculptures look harsh in the asphalt median. Please consider pushing for a landscaped median to bring this art into harmony with the neighborhood. I have taken the liberty to create a rendering for a thoughtful landscape plan. This simple plan would include Pine Muhly grasses (*muhlenbergia dubia*) and whales tongue agave. The sculptures would have two soft up lights and ground mulched with ‘Mojave Gold’ rock mulch. Here is my amateur rendering of an ideal plan:
