Silverado Spade Tournament RULES

Players per table: four

- Everyone plays for themselves (cutthroat, no partners)
- How to win the game round: The first player to reach or pass 200 points wins the game; highest score wins. If a game ends in a tie, a new hand will be dealt to determine the winner.
- No penalty on Sandbagging: Overtricks are known as bags. Usually, players who accumulate bags are penalized; however, in our tournament, we'll waive that rule
- Scoring Rules: A player receives 10 points for each trick bid; however, if a player takes in more tricks than his/her bid, the player receives one bag for each trick over the bid.
- Scoring for an Unsuccessful Bid rule: If a player fails to reach his/her bid, the player loses 10 points for each trick bid.
- Scoring for a Successful or Unsuccessful Nil rule: A nil is a 0 bid. If a player bids nil and is successful (takes no tricks), the player receives 100 points. If a player bids nil and is unsuccessful (takes in one or more tricks), the player loses 100 points.
- Reneging rule: A renege is a player's failure to follow the lead suit when he/she has a card of that suit in hand. Any player who reneges will lose 50 points for the deal and the other players will be awarded their bid. The deal will immediately be finished, and a new one will be dealt out.
