FEES & PAYMENTS

Payment of fees is required at the time of registration.

REFUND POLICY

If a class or program is cancelled by the department, a full refund will be given. Refunds will be issued if requested by the close of business on the first day of class. No refunds will be issued after the first day of class. Credits issued to household account will expire after 90 days.

Day Camp registration cancelled by an individual will be refunded 100% only if notice of nonattendance is given by the Wednesday of the prior week.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Clark County Parks & Recreation is committed to providing services to the public at moderate, low and no cost. The Department is also committed to making its programs accessible to all segments of the population. To this end, the Department has established a scholarship program, which provides financial support to qualifying Clark County residents for selected department programs, as funding is available.

DRESS CODE




