All rifle and pistol venues are timed events. Once firing has commenced there will be no allowance for misfires or detachment of the target from its backer. Staff will assure all paper targets are secured properly. Any bullet touching outer edge of colored area will be scored as a hit.

A single misfire for any reason will be allowed during rapid-fire pistol shooting. Contestant will be provided with one additional 5-second period. However, results of any targets fired upon prior to the misfire will be scored. Any, and all targets fired at once the allotted time has expired will be scored as a miss.

Shotgun

1000 rounds of 12-gauge provided by



Load only one shell at a time during Skeet. Load only one shell at a time during Trap. Load two shells for 5-Stand. (Report Pairs!) Trap or 5-Stand- Always walk behind the other shooters when moving from station 5 to 1. All ammunition must be removed, & action open any time you're moving from station to station. For a clay target to be scored "dead" there must be a visible piece from the target observed by the scorekeeper. Movement, or just "dust" from the target results in a score of "lost".

General Information/ Shooting Procedures

Final Registration- Shotgun Center; 8am-10am if space available. Final Check-in 1pm

Important!

For this unique tournament, only firearms and ammo provided by the Shooting Complex and our sponsors will be used.

Groups of 4 Will Begin Every 15 Minutes at the Education Center 50yd Range!

Starting at 9am sharp, group 1 will enter the 50yd range of the Education Center and work their way from right to left completing venues 1 - 3 in 15 minutes. All group members shoot together until each venue is completed.

Group 2 will take the 50yd range at 9:15 as Group 1 moves to the 100yd range. This procedure will continue to repeat itself until the last group has taken the firing line.

Targets for this Program!

Paper targets with 3" bull's eyes are used for "bench" shooting on venues 2 and 5, and 6" bull's eyes are used for "standing" on venues 1, 3 & 4. Shooting Complex staff and volunteers will assist the competitors with placement of targets on moveable 24" target frames. All targets are scored "Hit" or "Miss". Competitors should sign each of their paper targets indicating they agree with the score.

Rapid-fire targets are comprised of 5 selfhealing discs that are each 6" in diameter. These are placed across the top of a freestanding sawhorse structure approximately 10" apart, center-to center. Shooters have 5 shots and 5 seconds to topple each disc.

All Shotgun Center events use the standard 4¹/₄" diameter full orange clays.

Ear & Eye Protection Mandatory at All Shooting Venues!

Course of Fire- Rifle/Pistol

Standing= No Artificial Support or Brace One or Two Hands Allowed for Pistol Shooting

Venues Shot in the Following Order from **East** to **West** at Education Center Ranges

Ed Center 50yd Range

- 1. .22 Rifle Standing, 10 shots, 25 yds, 2 min.
- 2. .22 Rifle Bench, 10 shots, 50 yds, 2.5 min.
- 3. **CF Pistol Standing**, 5 shots, 15 yds, 1 min.

Ed Center 100yd Range

- 4. CF Rifle Standing, 5 shots, 25 yds, 1 min.
- 5. **CF Rifle Bench**, 5 shots, 50 yds, 1.5 min.

Ed Center Multi-Use Range

6. **CF Pistol Rapid-Fire**, 5 shots, 10 yds, 5 sec.

At Completion of Venue 6 Proceed Directly to Shotgun Center to Begin Venue 7.

Venues Shot in the Following Order from West to East at the Shotgun Center

- 7. Field 7 or 6: American Skeet, 10 shots, Singles Only, 2 per post; 1 High, 1 Low, on each station; 2,3,4,5 & 6
- 8. Field 4 or 3: American Trap, 16yd, 10 shots, 2 per station
- 9. Field 1: 5-Stand, 10 shots, 1 report pair per station.

Advanced Registration is Recommended!

If Registering as a Team

Walk-ins will be accepted the day of the event on a <u>space-available</u> basis only.

Saturday Morning Check-In

Final registration and payment of any unpaid fees will commence at 8:00am December 7, 2024, in the main room of the Shotgun Center. Cash, check, or Visa/Mastercard accepted. Official score cards will be issued at this time. Check-In will end at 1:00pm for those shooting later in the day. Completed score cards must be submitted no later than 3:30pm.

In the Event of Ties-

Any individuals or team members involved in a tie will be recognized as Co-Champions and will receive duplicate awards.

Awards Presentations- 4:15pm! Unique Gold, Silver & Bronze medals were created exclusively for this event.

Miscellaneous!

As mentioned previously, appropriate firearms and ammunition will be provided for your use at the location of each venue.

Practice

Trap, Skeet, 5-Stand, Rifle or Pistol practice is available anytime the Shooting Complex is open for public shooting. Daily range fees

at the Public Rifle/Pistol Center are currently \$13, or \$6.50 for those under 18 years of age. A junior-age shooter may also accompany a paid adult for no extra fee.

Trap or Skeet is currently \$8.00 for 25 targets, and a promotional rate of \$6.00 is offered every Thursday. The Junior rate is also \$6.00 and available anytime.

5-Stand is currently \$9.00 for 25 targets.

On Friday, December 6, or during the day of the event, you may purchase a special 10target practice ticket at a cost of \$3.50 for use on the trap or skeet fields.

5-Stand practice will be <u>unavailable</u> on the day of the event.

While visiting our facility, be sure to also check out our sporting clays course and archery center.
