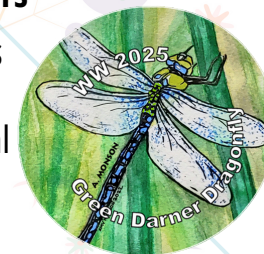

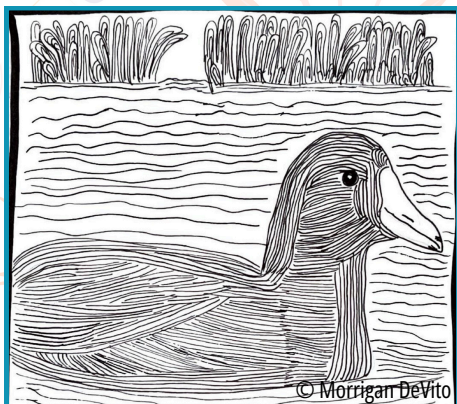
Spotlight on Nature Gallery
