

MINUTES
CLARK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING,

YUCCA MOUNTAIN NUCLEAR WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING
FEBRUARY 7, 2006

Irene Navis, chairwoman, called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

1. **Welcome and Introductions:** Irene Navis welcomed the attendees (**Exhibit A**), and asked them to introduce themselves. **Members present** were Curtis Brown, Cleveland Dudley, Caren Levenson, Peggy Maze Johnson, Melvin McCallum, Calvin Meyers, Irene Navis, Frank Perna, David Vincelette, Holly Woodward, and Eric Young. **Members excused** were Louis Carr, Michael Cyphers, Clete Kus, Maggie Plaster, Daryl Thomé, Richard Wells, and Dr. William Wells. **Members absent** were Brok Armantrout, Carolyn Goolsby Manuel, and Maria Rodriguez.
2. **Consideration of Meeting Minutes:** The members unanimously approved the minutes.
3. **DOE Progress and Member Updates:**
 - Frank Perna reiterated his statement that President George W. Bush does not keep his campaign promises.
 - John Hartley, Bechtel Science Applications International Corporation (BSAIC), provided a brief update and asked questions of the group that resulted in a lengthy discussion about the County's position.
 - Irene reviewed her handouts: Department of Energy (DOE) report, *Focusing on the Nation's Priorities*; report on the President's 2007 budget, *Energy*; January 17, 2006, NEI letter; news release from Governor Kenny C. Guinn dated February 6, 2006; and, Joe Strolin's, Nevada Agency for Nuclear Projects, e-mail, *Department of Energy Announces New Nuclear Initiative (Exhibit B)*.
 - Irene attended the Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board February 2, 2006, and provided the highlights from the meeting.
 - County consultants will be presenting two papers at the Nuclear Waste Symposia '06, Tucson, Arizona, February 27-March 2, 2006.
 - Irene said the EIS for the Caliente Corridor may be ready late spring or early summer.
 - The National Academy of Sciences study on transportation is scheduled to be released February 9, 2006.
 - The book on the Intelligent Transportation System, authored by Clark County contractor, Urban Environmental Research, is scheduled for release early this spring.
 - Erik Muller, Public Information Officer, reported future outreach events including the upcoming Chinese New Year, February 12, 2006.
4. **Discuss committee roles, responsibilities, and activities for 2006:** Held to the next meeting.
5. **Next meeting date; select agenda items:** The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for March 6, 2006, Pueblo Room, Clark County Government Center.
