

CLARK COUNTY AAPI COMMUNITY COMMISSION MEETING

In Clark County, the number AAPI students are in line with AAPI teachers.

- For the 2022-23 school year in Clark County we find that 5.9% of the student population identifies as Asian compared to 7% of our licensed personnel.
- 1.6% of our student population identifies as Pacific Islander while 1.1% of our licensed personnel do.



The percentage of Clark County administrative personnel is less in line with our student population.

Teaching and administrative personnel in Clark County is becoming more diverse overall.



- The number of Asian licensed personnel in CCSD grew from 731 in 2018-19 to 1280 in the most recent 2022-23 school year.
- The number of Asian Pacific Islander licensed personnel grew from 110 in 2018-19 to 137 in 2022-23 and our Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander identifying personnel grew from 54 in 2018-2019 to 74 in 2022-23.

- The Clark County Asian Administrative staff grew from 1.98% in 2018-19 to 2.89% by the 2022-23 school year.
- The number of Administrative staff that identifies as Pacific Islander grew from .37% in 2018-19 to .8% in the 2022-23 school year.
