Senate Bill 92

Also known as the Street Vendors Bill, creates a framework for local governments to help street vendors legitimize their businesses and obtain licenses. The bill also creates the Task Force on Safe Sidewalk Vending within the Secretary of State's Office to help identify challenges and remove unnecessary barriers for street vendors. The Task Force is comprised of nine members, including representatives from the health district, a county or city, the gaming or restaurant industry, law enforcement, street vendors, and the community organizations that represent and advocate for them.

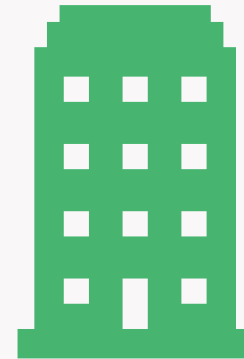
**Are you
required to
obtain a state
business
license?**

In summary, NRS 76.100 mandates that individuals or entities must obtain a state business license from the Secretary of State before conducting business in Nevada. Entities required to file an initial or annual list must be licensed at the time of filing, while those not required to file such lists must be licensed before commencing business activities in the state.

Fee



Sole Proprietorship: \$200.00



LLC: \$425.00

The main difference between a Nevada LLC and a sole proprietorship is the way the two structures handle taxes and the way they handle responsibilities within the organization. Additional fees can be found: <https://www.nvsos.gov/sos/businesses/commercial-recordings/forms-fees>

What documents are required?

Sole Proprietorship: No formation documents required.

LLC: The Articles of Organization are a document that officially establishes your LLC by stating basic information about it.

Prepare Articles of Organization and file them with the Nevada Secretary of State to register your Nevada LLC properly. This simply means filling out the online form and submitting it.

**How long
does it take

This will depend on the type of application submitted and whether it has been made online. Approximately 30 days if filed on paper, or immediately if filed online.

STEPS FOR ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

- The name of your LLC
- The name, address, and signature of your registered agent. Registered agents must also sign a certificate of acceptance of appointment by the registered agent
- The date of dissolution of the LLC (if any)
- The name and address of the person forming the LLC
- Management structure: Will the managers or members manage the LLC?
- The name and address of each manager or managing member
- The person forming the LLC is required to sign the articles
- The initial report should be submitted with the articles
- Business license required with items
